The Alliance Française de Nashville is pleased to announce the Nina Walls Scholarship for 2010. Please use the following information yourself, or pass it on to others who may be interested.

The Nina Walls Scholarship was established to honor the memory of Nina Walls, a founding member of the Alliance Française de Nashville. Her deep interest in France and in the French language was an inspiration to all who knew her.

FEATURES OF THE SCHOLARSHIP

The Nina Walls Scholarship will enable the recipient to attend a session this summer (either in June or in July) at the Alliance Française in Lyon, France. The recipient will be lodged in a French home and will eat with the family in the mornings at breakfast and in the evenings at dinner.

The Scholarship will pay for the cost of tuition and fees at the Alliance Française de Lyon and for room and half-board with a French family. The Scholarship will also contribute \$600 toward the recipient's travel or other expenses.

ELIGIBILITY

One of the major purposes of the scholarship is to give an individual who is currently teaching French the opportunity to absorb French culture while improving his or her fluency in the language. Any certified, full-time teacher who is presently teaching French in a Middle Tennessee school at the primary, secondary, or junior college level and who has never been awarded the Nina Walls scholarship is eligible to apply.
